Judges for run-offs will be determined on the day of the trial.

Jump Height Order

Obedience classes with jumps will be run as follows.

- Saturday will run short-to-tall starting with 4" jump height, except for Utility B/Preferred Utility which will start with 20"
- Sunday will run short-to-tall starting with 24" jump height, except for Utility B/Preferred Utility which will start with 4".

Rally classes with jumps will be run short-to-tall in all trials.

Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

- **Entries must be submitted on an official AKC entry form**
- **Entry forms must be complete, physically signed, and include the agreement**
- **Entry forms MUST be scanned as a PDF and sent via email to emstrialsecretary@outlook.com**
- **Photos of entry forms WILL NOT be accepted**
- **A Square invoice will be sent from the Club Treasurer, with a 5% convenience fee added. Upon receipt of both the properly completed entry form and the Square payment, your entry will be processed.**

You must waive the signature requirement on all express deliveries.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

Pre-Order Catalogs

Catalogs may be pre-ordered at **\$10.00** per catalog. Please include payment with your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial for \$10.00 per catalog.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.

Mound City Obedience Training Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience or Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per trial for injured dogs or handlers. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's or doctor's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for being ready for judging when called to the ring. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Mound City Obedience Training Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Checks for canceled entries will be shredded — no check will be returned.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring. Warm-up must be done on lead.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the show site and at all hotels, motels, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Mound City Obedience Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Mound City Obedience Training Club, their Board, Members, and Dog Sports at Kim's and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

DOGS NOT OWNED OR HANDLED BY EXHIBITORS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING AT THESE TRIALS.

The building is available for **set up on Thursday, February 20 from 3 pm to 6:30 pm**.

Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after the trial is completed.

No advertising flyers may be placed without permission of MCOTC and Dog Sports at Kim's. No strollers or playpens allowed in building.

Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, MCOTC will take appropriate action.

No dogs may be left in the facility overnight.

No professional photography or videography without permission.

No gasoline or diesel generators.

No alcoholic beverages allowed at event site.

NO SMOKING is allowed in the building or within 20' of the entrances.

Dogs are to be exercised in specifically marked areas only. Owners must pick up after their dogs.

Transfers

Transfers will be allowed according to AKC Regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
